- Approves or rejects items and documents inspection results; communicates with internal customers as required to resolve inspection, engineering, and manufacturing challenges
- Performs dimensional and visual inspections of a variety of manufactured components including mechanical parts, assemblies, weldments, etc. for compliance to drawings and all specifications
- Ensures that manufacturing processes are performed as per engineering drawings and applicable standards and specifications
- Works closely with other departments to ensure on-time delivery of quality products

- Ability to complete complex mathematical equations and read complex mechanical drawings; Proficient with reading blueprints and GD&T interpretations
- Skilled in use of inspection tools, including calipers, micrometers, surface gauges, height gauges; CMM and Romer Arm experience

- Experience operating milling machines, surface grinders, drill presses, hand tools, and precision instruments
